MINUTES

LCSD QUARTERLY MEETING
THURSDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2014 6:30pm
Templeton CSD Board Room

Call to order/ roll call President Gary Hubbard called the meeting to order at 6:35. Present were Gary Hubbard, president; Miller Newlon, Vice President; Ellen Frost, Secretary; James Dempsey and Doris Somerville, Directors; Conny Gut, non-voting Treasurer; Debbie Arnold, Supervisor District Five SLO County; Matt Reinhart and Kidd Immel, Public Works Commission and one guest.

Consent Agenda

Minutes for Quarterly Meeting on July 10, 2014. Motion to approve Newlon/Hubbard. Vote to approve 5 yes, 0 no.

Old Business

The Board agreed to cover new business first to accommodate guest speakers and visitors

New Business

Geneseo Bridge. The Board of Public works will be building a bridge across the broken Arizona crossing on Geneseo at the Huer Huero Creek. Matt Reinhart gave the background that the old bridge was condemned in 1948. A resident was given permission to haul off the remnants of the bridge in 1952 and the road has crossed the Huer Huero Creek at that location since then. Kidd Immel gave further information that a traffic study clocked 900 trips per day in 2010 and it was projected to rise to 1300 trips by 2030. The new bridge construction is expected to begin in 2018. The portions of Geneseo Road and Linne Road near the bridge will close for two to three months. Construction cannot be done from Mid-April to Mid-October due to existing environmental requirements.

The Board wanted to go on record with the County and Public Works that additional traffic and commercial vehicles during bridge construction may impact or damage the District Roads which are privately maintained through an assessment of residents. We asked Matt Reinhart and Kidd Immel and Supervisor Debbie Arnold to see if the county can assist us in mitigating damage to our roads.

Supervisor Arnold will make some inquiries from County sources. The LCSD Board will draft a letter to the Public Works Commission, Supervisor Arnold and Cal Trans to explain the situation and ask for any available assistance should the roads be damaged beyond the district's fiscal ability to repair them. We will try to use photo documentation to show the roads before construction so that we can later use photos to document unusual damages.

The Board decided to address all the other agenda items at a special meeting which will be scheduled as soon as possible.
